Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) on overall institutional performance:

A Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) was taken up by the IQAC, Demow College in which most of the students participated. The students were asked various questions regarding their college life through which their progress could be measured. Majority of the students wrote that they attended their classes regularly. 90% of the students expressed satisfaction that their teachers were available when they approached them. All the students mentioned that they got study materials and notes from their teachers for clarity and understanding of their respective subjects. Most of the students surveyed also mentioned they approached their teachers for guidance and assistance. To the question regarding the coverage of syllabus, most of the students expressed satisfaction that the syllabus was covered within time. However, a few also expressed dissatisfaction and did not find the coverage of syllabus adequate. Majority of the students were satisfied with the overall performance in internal assessment. They also wrote that they got the opportunity to participate in activities beyond the classroom such as workshops, projects and fieldworks. However most of them agreed that there is scope for improvement in all the fields and the teaching-learning environment could be made more interactive. Majority of the students were also satisfied with the physical infrastructure of the college, particularly the college library. They found the collection of books, journals and reading materials of the college library adequate. However they also expressed some dissatisfaction in areas like canteen facility, internet facility, Girls' Common room etc. Most of the respondents mentioned that they took part in cocurricular activities of the college. Many students also mentioned that they were part of the NCC unit of the college.
